

## Fairline Boats - Oundle

The Fairline marque was born of one man's vision and passion for excellence. Jack Newington, the company's founder, was a man committed to the highest ideals of quality and integrity; more than that, he had the rare ability to take his own high standards and values and weave them into the fabric of what was to become the hugely successful enterprise that is the Fairline of today.

This was the benchmark set for the construction of the new Fairline Boats head office, and this high standard has been achieved, from the central atrium containing a feature helical staircase and limestone flooring, right through to the contemporary sanitaryware, this two storey office building has quality throughout, and is a perfect advert for the high class quality produced by Fairline.

The initial concept design, by PGD Architects, was progressed by the main contractor, PGR Construction, as a design and build project, with architectural services provided by PGD.

Gowing & Hunt Limited and their team of specialist subcontractors, designed, installed and commissioned the complete heating, air conditioning, ventilation, hot and cold water services and above ground drainage systems.

Heat recovery fresh air ventilation units complete with systems of galvanised ductwork has been installed within all office areas.

VRF Heating and cooling to the majority of areas is provided by ducted air conditioning units mounted above the ceilings.

Ancillary areas are heated by radiators, served by a wall mounted, gas fired fully condensing balanced flue boiler. This boiler also provides primary hot water to the hot water storage cylinders sited within the ancillary areas.
